Female worms produce eggs in the lungs that are coughed up and swallowed, and then passed in the feces. Dogs become infected by eating food or drinking water that is contaminated with larvated eggs. After being eaten, the eggs hatch in the intestine and then travel to the lungs through the circulatory system.

The larvae migrate through the liver, reach the lungs via the bloodstream, are coughed up, swallowed, and mature to egg-producing adults in the small intestine. Many larvae will be carried by the bloodstream to other parts of the dog's body and remain in the tissues of the dog for years in an inactive form.

Pinworms are small tubular white worms that range in size from 1 millimeter to 13 mm, or 0.03 inch to 0.5 inch. They infect the intestinal tract and can cause severe itching around the anus. Pinworms don't infect dogs, however; they limit themselves mainly to humans, rabbits and horses.
