The phylum Echinodermata is the largest group to include only marine animals, as there are no known freshwater or terrestrial species. The name echinoderm comes from the ancient Greek term for spiny skin, and many echinoderms are covered in spines.

The subphylum Chelicerata (New Latin, from French chélicère, from Greek χηλή, khēlē "claw, chela" and κέρας, kérias "horn") constitutes one of the major subdivisions of the phylum Arthropoda.It contains the sea spiders, arachnids (including scorpions, spiders, and potentially horseshoe crabs), and several extinct lineages, such as the eurypterids.
