The SDRT4 is a group-administered diagnostic test designed to identify specific strengths and weaknesses in reading. It provides detailed coverage of skills in phonetic analysis, vocabulary, comprehension, and scanning. Because the test is intended for use with low achievers, it contains easier questions than most achievement tests do.
